<b>Autumn 1</b>	Talk about media and technology and leisure. Use the present, perfect tenses and near future as well as the negative form and asking questions.	Talk about the environment. Use the present participle, 'être en train de' perfect and imperfect tenses. Use the comparative and superlative, passive voice, imperative with nous, 'rien' and 'personne'.
<b>Autumn 2</b>	Talk about my personal world, friends and family relationships and idols. Use reflexive verbs, possessive pronouns, adjectives, direct object pronouns and 3 time frame.	Talk about where I live. Use demonstrative adjectives, 'y', depuis, à or de + definite article. Use Si clauses, ask questions in 3 tenses, Negatives, Adjectives before nouns, possession.
<b>Spring 1</b>	Talk about school life. Use the present, perfect, imperfect and future tenses as well as comparative and superlative, impersonal verb structures and indirect object pronouns.	Talk about future plans. Express the future tense, use avant de, après avoir, prepositional verbs. Use verbs in masculine, feminine plural forms, use infinitives as nouns.
<b>Spring 2</b>	Talk about lifestyle and wellbeing. Use the present, perfect, imperfect and future tenses as well as reflexive verbs in the perfect tense. Use modal verbs, imperative form, partitive articles and the pronoun 'en'.	Revision programme.
<b>Summer 1 and 2</b>	<b>Mock Exam Period</b> Revision programme. Understand exam and revision technics. Talk about travel and tourism. Use the present, perfect, imperfect and future tenses, conditional, relative pronouns qui, que, modal verbs in the perfect tense. Si structures.	SUMMER EXAMS
